



Instructions to Applicants – 2027 Registrar Priority List

There are **51** Rehabilitation Registrar training positions available in Victoria for 2027. Each training position is for a minimum 6-month term. AFRM accreditation status for training sites can be found at <https://www.racp.edu.au/trainees/accredited-training-sites>.

Applicants **must** be registered to practise in Australia as a medical practitioner. Additionally, please check the requirements for Advanced Training in Rehabilitation Medicine. If you are uncertain if you fulfil the requirements, please contact RACP: <https://www.racp.edu.au/contact-us/>.

RMTV has encouraged employing Health Services that they should consider preferencing current AFRM trainees. Current AFRM trainees, however, cannot be guaranteed positions as the selection of trainees is the sole responsibility of the employing Health Services.

Application for Victorian Registrar Positions is a 2-stage process:

1. Apply directly to the employing health service.

- *The closing date for applications of Friday 19th June 2026 (approximate) has been supported by employing health services.* Applicants are advised to check the exact date with the relevant facilities, along with the preferred method of application.
- Each participating health service will determine whether a formal interview is required.

2. Submission of a Registrar Priority List to Rehabilitation Medicine Training Victoria.

- Once you have applied to the various employing health services and decided on your preferences, you then submit a Registrar Priority List to RMTV's Medical Education Officer.
- The Registrar Priority list enables candidates to list job preferences and be allocated to an employing health service.
- When completing your Registrar Priority List:
 - Number preferences from 1 to 51 (or as many as you have applied to) according to priority
 - Do this for EACH of Terms 1 and 2.
 - Candidates are strongly advised to apply for a number of positions, as it will increase your likelihood of obtaining a position
 - ONLY list sites/rotations they are prepared to accept an offer of employment for each term in 2027
 - *The closing date for submission of your Registrar Priority List is 5pm on **Friday 24th July 2026.***
- Late applications or changes to your priority list will **NOT** be accepted after this date.
- Applicants reserve the right to refuse the position being offered following the allocation meeting.
- The allocation meeting will occur on Wednesday 29th July 2026, at a virtual meeting

between employing health services unit heads and RMTV.

- Unless there are remaining unallocated positions, a candidate will be offered a position with a health service only if they have applied directly to that employing health service prior to the allocation meeting.
- Successful candidates will be notified directly by the employing health service.

By submitting this Priority List, you are agreeing to release your contact details to parties involved in the Registrar Selection process including, but not limited to, Directors or Heads of Rehabilitation Units within Victoria. The information is used solely as a means to contact successful and unsuccessful applicants following the allocation meeting.

An acknowledgement of your priority list submission will be sent by email (if provided) usually within 3 business days if sent by email, fax or by mail. **If you do not receive this acknowledgement, you are advised to check that your priority list has been received.** Members of RMTV staff involved in the selection process will accept no responsibility for non-receipt of a priority list.
